

Renewable Energy Incentives

Wind Turbines, Solar Voltaic Systems, Other Renewable Systems Under 40 kW—Rebate is 30-cents per kWh of the total system output for a 5-year period. The total incentive amount is capped at 20% of the system cost or \$7,500. Requires interconnection and net metering. Any required engineering fees to be paid for by the applicant.

Additional systems have to be metered separately to qualify for incentives.

Solar Hot Water Systems—Rebate is 15% of the system cost up to \$2,500 and require a site assessment by a certified auditor. Jackson Electric Cooperative will pay for half of the assessment after the successful completion of the project. In addition, we use the same requirements as the Focus on Energy program, such as requiring a certified, professional installer, two-year installation warranty, one-year main component warranty and a five-year warranty on the collectors.

Terms and Conditions:

Programs provide rebates/incentives for the qualifying purchase and installation of products and/or services for members receiving electric service from Jackson Electric Cooperative.

Jackson Electric Cooperative reserves the right to verify sales receipts before issuing rebates/incentives. Rebates/incentives under \$250 will be issued in the form of a credit to the member's electric account. Please allow four to six weeks to process the rebate/incentive application.

Rebate/Incentive Programs

Residential Lighting, Appliance and Device Rebates

Rebates are available when you purchase qualifying ENERGY STAR lighting, appliances and devices.

ENERGY STAR Lighting Rebates

- Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFLs) - \$1 per bulb (not to exceed the cost of the bulb)
- LED Holiday Lights—\$2/string (min. 25 bulbs per string)

ENERGY STAR Appliance and Device Rebates

- Clothes Washer—\$75
- Dishwasher—\$50
- Dehumidifier—\$25
- Refrigerator—\$75
- Freezer—\$25
- Room Air Conditioner—\$25
- TV—\$25
- Computer Monitor—\$25



Residential Heating and Cooling Incentives

Whether you're building a new home or replacing an older, high-operating-cost heating and/or cooling system with an energy efficient system, incentives are available.

Ground Source Heat Pump—\$500/ton

Air Source Heat Pump—\$250/ton. SEER rating must be 14 or above or HSPF 7.7 or greater.

Electronic Commutator Motor (ECM) Blowers—\$75/furnace. Must be installed with a heat pump system or strip heat to qualify.

Heat Pump Water Heater—\$300/unit. Efficiency rating must be 2.00 or greater.

Home Improvement Incentives

Having a home that is more energy efficient will help you reduce your energy bills and improve your comfort. Jackson Electric Cooperative offers existing home incentives.

Existing Home Performance Assessment—Jackson Electric Cooperative will pay one-half the cost of a home performance assessment and one-half the cost of the post inspection, providing at least one of what is designated as a "critical recommended improvement" is completed correctly as verified by the post inspection. Jackson Electric Cooperative will pay 50% of the weatherization improvements not to exceed \$500 for non-dual fuel homes and \$1,000 for homes actively participating in the dual fuel program.

Wattmeter Lending Program—Use a wattmeter free of charge or purchase a meter to measure how much energy your appliances and other household equipment are using.

New Home Program

Jackson Electric Cooperative provides financial incentives for new homes that are built to exceed the UDC minimum energy standards. Program requirements and financial incentives are specific. Please refer to the New Home Program rebate form for program details before construction plans are finalized.

Customized Energy Incentives— Commercial and Agricultural
